



## Security awareness

This course is based on U.S. Maritime Administration's Model Course MTSA 04-03, Maritime Security Awareness. This course is divided into five parts, each one followed by a questionnaire.

This course is intended to provide the knowledge required for all personnel working onboard ships, who are not assigned specific duties in connection with a ship security plan.

### Learning objectives and learner outcomes:

Those who successfully complete the course should be able to demonstrate sufficient knowledge to support the implementation of relevant maritime security plans. This knowledge shall include, but is not limited to:

- The meaning and the consequential requirements of the different security levels
- Knowledge of emergency procedures and contingency plans
- Recognition and detection of weapons, dangerous substances, and devices
- Recognition, on a non-discriminatory basis, of characteristics and behavioural patterns of persons who are likely to threaten security
- Techniques used to circumvent security measures.

### Course prerequisites:

The course is open to all seafarers and to those working ashore in the shipping industry.
